Meals & Supplies

<u>Breakfast, Lunch & Snack Provided</u> At RosyLane we offer all students a healthy breakfast each morning, a balanced and nutritious lunch, and a healthy afternoon snack. Menus will be posted monthly in the brightwheel app.

<u>Classroom supplies</u> All needed school supplies will be provided to each child and all on-site curriculum material is included in tuition. We also supply a sheet, pillow, and blanket for daily rest period.

<u>Parents Need to Provide</u> A leak-proof water bottle, a change of clothing as appropriate for their child's needs and the season, indoor footwear (or socks) to keep our classroom clean, and outdoor footwear and gear. Please label your child's items.

Days & Hours of Operation

<u>Preschool Program (3-5 yrs.)</u> Operates on the school year calendar (September – mid-June) **8:15 am – 3:45 pm, Monday – Thursday**. Tuition is based on enrollment

- \$234 for full-time 4-day program
 *Limited spaces are available for part-time students
- \$123 for 2-day (M/W or T/Th)
- Registration Begins Feb. 15th (for September program start)
- Placement is finalized July 1st (for September program start)

The first day of preschool begins the day after Labor Day. We do have some breaks built into our year.

Admission and Enrollment

- \$75 registration fee is required for all students each year
- \$300 deposit is required at time of registration
 (This deposit will hold your child's placement and will be applied to your fall tuition, however, should you withdraw from the program prior to attending in fall your deposit will not be refunded)
- To enroll in our preschool program, you must provide the following required documents: completed enrollment papers, registration fee, and deposit
- Children enrolled in the program need to be toilet-trained. This means the child knows when they need to use the bathroom and can manage most of their self-help needs when toileting
- RosyLane Early Learning Center uses the brightwheel app for our enrollment process, parent communication, and billing software
